In 2016 BCAL assisted Assael and L&G to secure full planning permission for 479 new BTR homes in 5 new buildings with ground floor commercial uses on the edge of the Walthamstow Wetlands.

BCAL were then novated to Contractor Galliford Try (subsequently Vistry partnerships) at RIBA Stage 4 through to completion in 2020.

This scheme includes a major new 1 Hectare public realm and extensive private amenity, including 6 separate roof gardens, tennis and shuffleboard courts, an outdoor heated 20m swimming pool/lido with bar, childrens play area, and formal lawn for events.

The whole development is pet-friendly, which has made a big impact in terms of helping new neighbours to connect with each other.

These provide 754 new homes, a theatre, three cafes, community focused commercial premises and has a mixed tenure of PRS, Social Housing and apartments for sale.

The public realm and enhanced public park unifies the 3 separate buildings and includes a plaza for community events, enhanced traffic-free, well-lit pedestrian connections meandering through groves of pine trees. A series of new water features including a pond, mirror pools and fountain jet plaza.

A major new play area, cafe and roof terraces, dramatic new lighting, green walls, blue roofs, rooftop allotment growing areas and extensive ground level planting and public seating make this a wonderful area to live and work.

Working closely with Essential Living, Architects GRID and interior designers Woods Bagot, the top of the building was transformed into a communal amenity facility with a wide range of indoor and outdoor opportunities for work, rest and play to help foster a sense of community and collective endeavor.

Externally there are growing areas, an outdoor kitchen, extensive seating including loungers and a range of planting habitats which creates a sheltered haven for people and wildlife. Subtle lighting extends the period of use into the evenings and external materials compliment the architecture and interiors.

Spaces were designed to be sub-divided for private exclusive hire and wi-fi boosters and power were provided to allow use of lap-tops for working from home.

Externally there are two roof terraces, ground floor public realm improvements, cafe terrace and communal gardens complimenting the ground floor internal 'Clubroom'.



CGI of Beth Calverley's poem: BCAL





A new waterside residential quarter featuring 347 pioneering, modern, modular homes is coming to Wirral Waters. Urban Splash developers and architects Shed KM are bringing their factory-built modular home HOUSE to Merseyside for the first time.

BCAL are the project landscape architects and have also designed and delivered advanced landscape infrastructure works, including a new adoptable cycleway and street tree planting along the Dock Road, a new Community Park and additional Dockside landscape works to compliment a series of new phased residential developments along the Northbank East Float.

Working closely with Essential Living and architects Assael, an extensive new public realm including creekside walkway and terraces was developed in collaboration with the Creekside Trust environmental charity, who are managing the terraces for Essential Living.

A children's nursery, pocket park and extensive private residential amenity at podium level and 5 separate roof-top terraces make this a family-friendly development.

BCAL worked closely with interior designers Woods Bagot and lighting designers Studio Fractal to create a co-ordinated amenity design inside and outside the buildings.

Extensive green walls, green and brown roofs and the inter-tidal terraces combine with the carefully chosen wildlife-friendly ground level planting to give a major enhancement to the area's biodiversity.
